



Graph: • Student Feedback 2022-23









Graph: Teachers Feedback 2022-23







Graph: Parent Feedback: 2022-23











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





Graph: Teachers Feedback 2020-21







Graph: Parent Feedback 2020-21












Graph: Parent Feedback 2019-20

for each parameter.






