Shriram Shikshan Sanstha's, Shriram Mahila Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya, Paniv was established in the year 2012. The college aims at the overall development of the students to become entrepreneurs and professionals in the respective disciplines. Every year a survey was conducted to assess the satisfaction of all the stakeholders (Students, Parents, Alumni, Teachers, and Employers) regarding curriculum of the college. The college is permanently affiliated to SNDT University, Mumbai and follow curriculum prescribed by university. Receiving positive or negative feedback from these stakeholders is important as both these are crucial in helping monitor and evaluate the provision. Listening to what stakeholder say is a contributing factor to running a successful college or institution.

Methodology

In every academic year, we ask all the stakeholders to fill a feedback form. Every year data was collected. The link of feedback form was made available to all stakeholders on their corresponding Class what's App group. Filling of feedback is voluntary.

For the academic year 2023-24 there were 312 registered students at the college. 66 students, 10 teachers, 48 parents ,10 alumni and 16 employers responded to the survey.

The analyses presented in this report are based on the responses of these stakeholders to the survey.

Student Feedback








