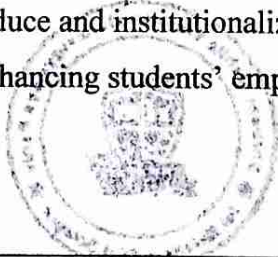

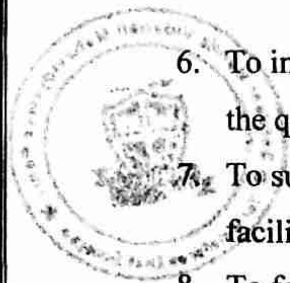
MISSION

6. ENVIRONMENTAL PROMOTION AND SUSTAINABILITY

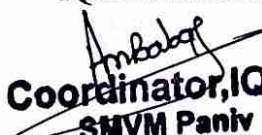
- ✓ To maintain and strengthen the vermicomposting system on the campus.
